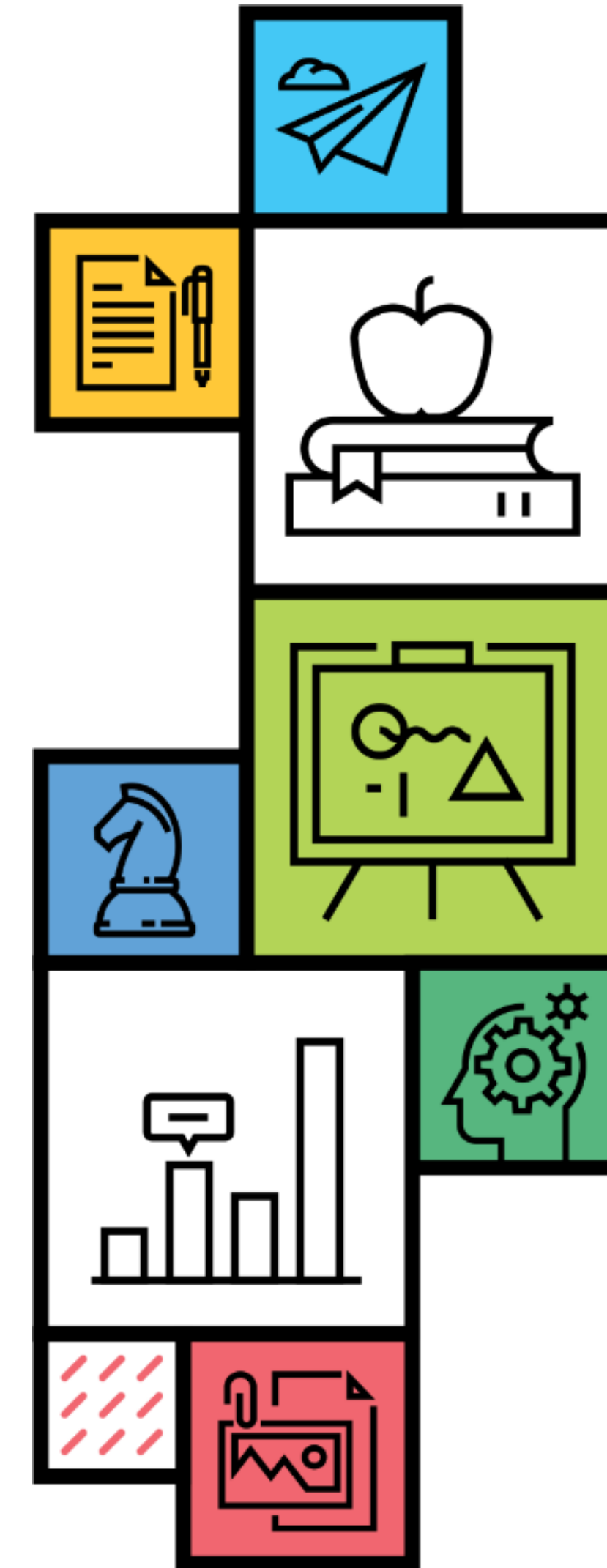

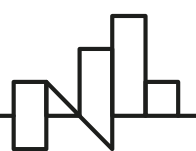
Objectives and outcomes

- Enhanced human capital and knowledge base in the Czech Republic
- Enhanced collaboration between the Czech Republic and donor states – all projects are bilateral (at least one partner from a donor state is mandatory)
- Open to all levels of education (from pre-primary school to tertiary level of education)
- Focused on school education
- Consists of four outcomes – type of projects



Facts

- EEA Grant € 6 500 000
- Programme Agreement signed on 21st November 2018
- Launch conference held on November 28, 2018 in Prague
- First calls launched on December 28, 2018
- Three rounds of calls planned – 2018, 2019, 2020



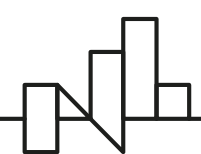
Institutional Cooperation Projects

- Outcome: Strengthened institutional cooperation at all levels of education, with a special focus on democracy and citizenship education
 - Modernisation or innovation of the curricula, development of joint study programmes and courses
 - Organization of peer learning activities and exchange of good practice in the field of teaching methodologies
- Priorities: democracy, citizenship and inclusive education (including Roma inclusion)
- Expected outputs: curricula, learning resources, teaching materials, studies, workshops, trainings, seminars, round tables etc.



Institutional Cooperation Projects

- 1st call submission deadline: March 11, 2019
- Project duration: 12 or 24 months
- Project start date: August 1, 2019
- Grant per project: € 20 000 - € 150 000



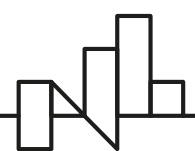
Mobility Projects

- Outcome: Improved skills and competences of students, staff and other educational experts at all levels of education
 - Students in secondary and higher education – school exchanges, study period abroad, traineeship
 - Duration: 2 weeks – 6 months
 - School and HE staff - Teaching, training, study visits, job shadowing
 - Duration: 1 week – 2 months
- Priorities: support of students from disadvantage groups, support of students – future teachers



Mobility Projects

- 1st call submission deadline: March 4, 2019
- Project duration: 13 months
- Project start date: August 1, 2019
- Grant per project: € 1 500 - € 100 000



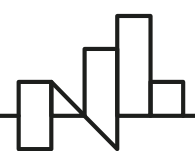
VET Projects

- Outcome: Improved quality of work-based learning and youth entrepreneurship
 - Partnership: focused on work-based learning and the needs of the local labour market
 - Increasing capacity of VET staff and company tutors through study visits
 - Redesigning curricula
 - Youth entrepreneurship: supporting the sense of entrepreneurship among young people
 - Organization of training activities for VET students, teachers and tutors
- Priorities: social inclusion, VET schools in disadvantaged areas, VET schools enrolling students from disadvantaged groups
- Expected outputs: established partnership following ECVET, redesigned curricula, trainings, courses, modules etc.



VET Projects

- 1st call submission deadline: March 18, 2019
- Project duration: 13 months
- Project start date: August 1, 2019
- Grant per project: € 10 000 - € 50 000



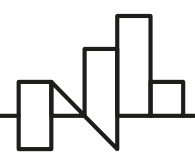
Inclusive Education Projects

- Outcome: Increased inclusion of disadvantaged groups including the Roma population
- Joint projects aim at developing competences and classroom-based skills of education professionals and multipliers, in particular those tasked with supporting inclusive approaches and working with Roma students
 - Focus on training, follow-up, mentoring, ongoing monitoring, evaluation, update of training curriculum
- Priorities: Roma inclusion
- Expected outputs: trainings on topics related to inclusive education



Inclusive Education Projects

- 1st call will be launched: beginning of March 2019
- 1st call submission deadline: May 2019
- Project duration: 12 or 24 months
- Project start date: September 1, 2019
- Grant per project: € 50 000 - € 200 000
